

- A major intervention for the Sunshine Coast / designated Priority Development Area
- Government planning indicates a significant transit-oriented regional CBD
- To create an identifiable city heart for the region (150,000m2 of commercial / 65,000m2 of retail / 2,000 apartments)
- An exercise in urban regeneration / city making and jobs creation over 20 years








CITY CENTRE PLANNING & DESIGN

- Government designated rail corridor and proposed light rail corridor, transit interchange (transit-oriented CBD)
- Key road connections across site to serve wider Maroochydore, street grid pattern, significant public realm
- Range of CBD uses in buildings up to 15-25 storeys
- Significant 3.6ha site for future regional premium hotel, entertainment and convention centre
