Mary, was born in Australia.


She is now 55 years old and has a partner but no kids.


Mary and her partner live in Tewantin, in a 3 bedroom house where they have been for the past 5 years. They own 2 cars.


Mary completed high school and later gained a certificate in management and commerce.


