Due to increases in property values and repaying some of her debt Mary's mortgage

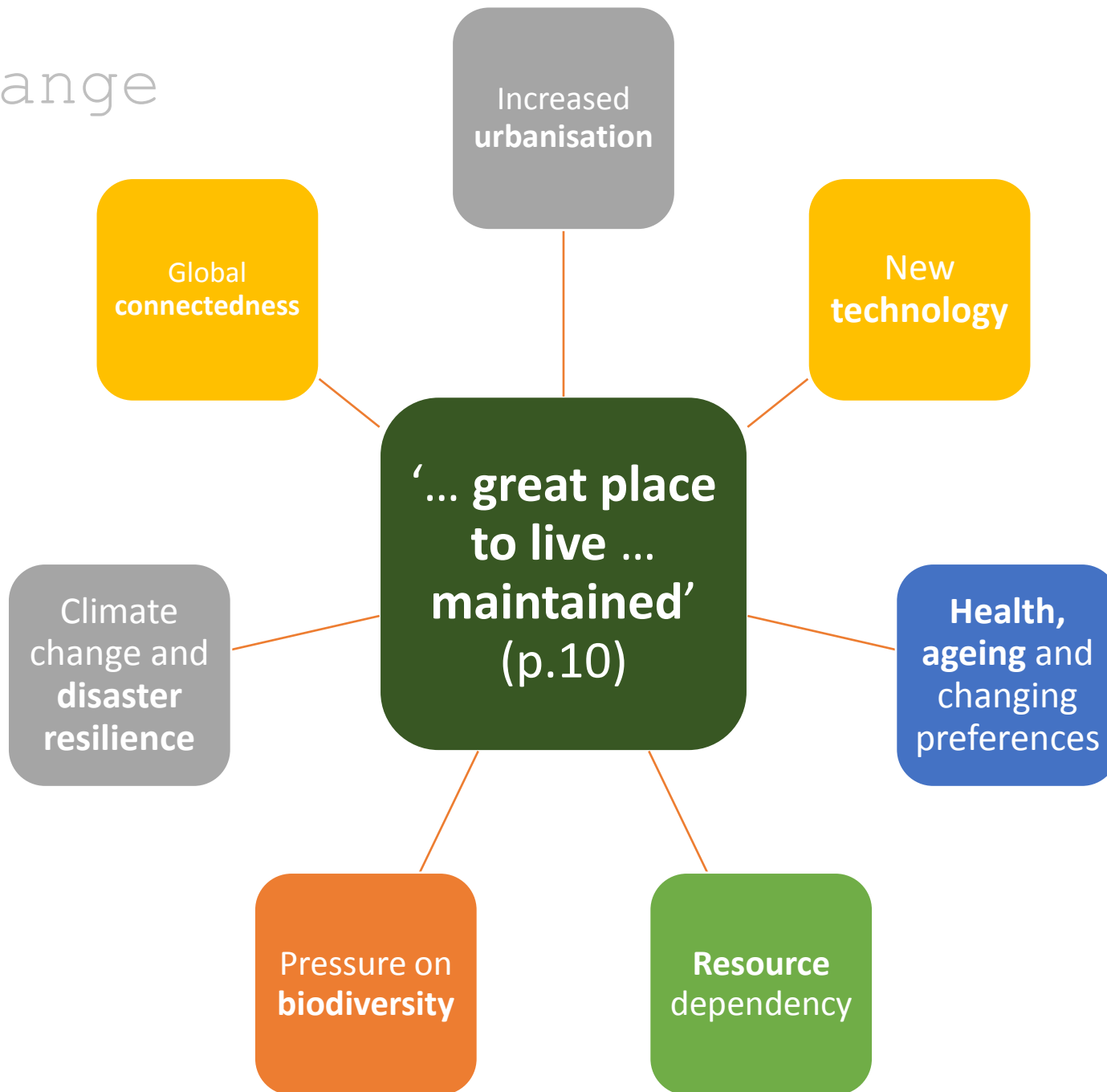

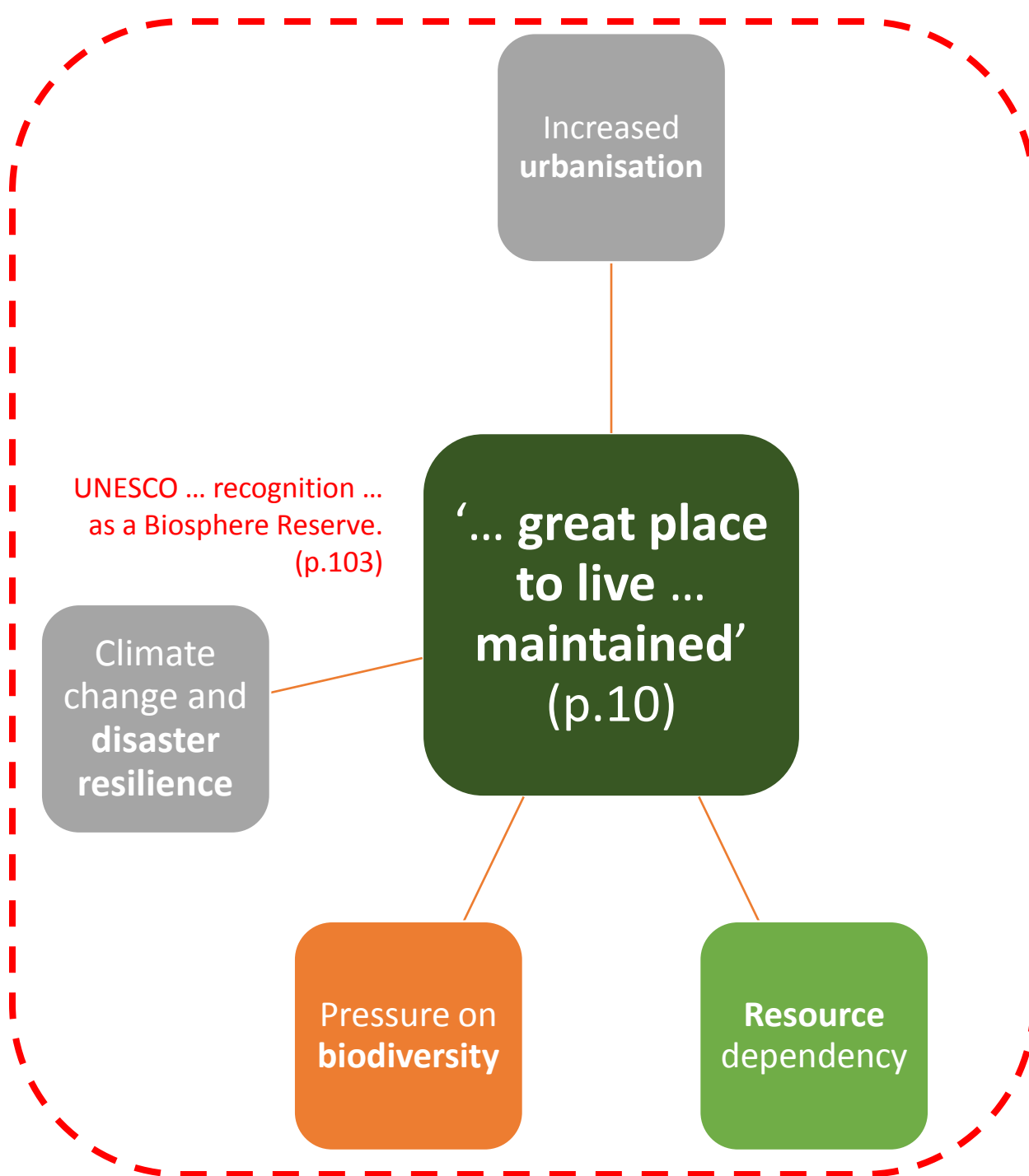

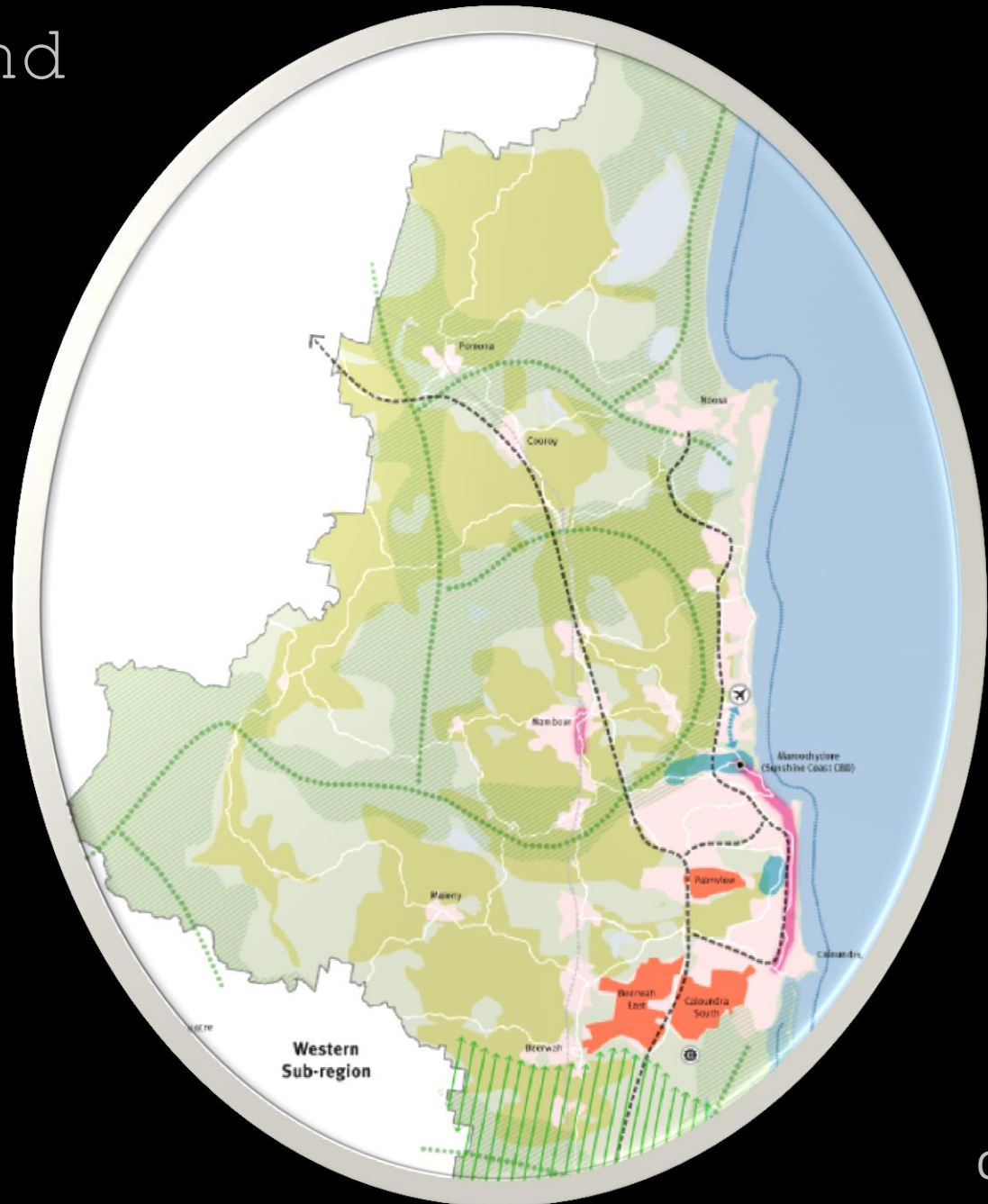
