





A CLEAR VISION FOR THE SC REGION THAT REFLECTS THE HEART AND SOUL OF THE REGION NOT THE SPECIFIC STRATEGIES OR PROJECTS OF THE LGA'S

START BY UNDERSTANDING WHAT IT IS YOU VALUE TODAY – In order to more clearly understand what you can be tomorrow – do we have a values based approach to strategy?
