# Increased international student numbers

- 273 International students in 2018
- average TAFE Queensland international student spends an additional \$18,000 per year during their stay.
- international students will contribute \$8.4 million into the local economy in 2018

- Local boom in health jobs and introduction of SCHI has resulted in rise in student numbers
- Nursing student numbers up 63.33% since 2013
- industry to grow by 9.6% from 2017 to 2022

# Building up the trades sector

- Predicted increase of 7.3% in construction jobs from 2017 to 2022
- TAFE Queensland placing a heavy focus on continuing to build apprenticeship numbers and participation in trades qualifications.
